A Guru's Journey Sarah Morelli,2019-12-20 An important modern exponent of Asian dance, Pandit Chitresh Das brought kathak to the United States in 1970. The Militant Song Movement in Latin America Pablo Vila, 2014-05-01 Latin America in the 1960s and 1970s underwent a profound and often violent process of social change.
